Virginia Dare Soil and Water Conservation Scholarship

College Scholarship Application & Guidelines

Deadline to Apply June 11, 2021

Purpose: To promote the education of Virginia Beach and Chesapeake High School Students in Agriculture, Environmental Education fields with an emphasis Natural Resource Conservation and Environmental Protection.

To give financial support to students majoring in or showing a strong desire to major in a course curriculum related to Natural Resource Conservation and/or Environmental Studies.

Qualifications: Scholarship will be awarded annually on behalf of the Virginia Dare of the Soil and Water Conservation District.

Individual applicants must be full-time students enrolled in or who have applied to a college freshman level curriculum. Applicants shall document a 2.5 greater Grade Point Average or appropriate equivalent of individual scholastic achievement. The applicant's most recent official school transcript must accompany the application. A copy of a school transcript will not be accepted. Applicants shall demonstrate active interest in Conservation, Agriculture or Environmental Studies.

Applications will only be accepted from students in City of Chesapeake or Virginia Beach. Student must reside or attend schools in either City. Eligible applicants must reside or attend school within the Virginia Dare Soil and Water Conservation District (Virginia Beach, Chesapeake)

Amount Awarded: \$1,500 scholarship will be awarded (multiple scholarships may be awarded)A check will be issued to the selected school on behalf of the student.

Deadlines:

June 11, 2021	District's selected applicant with all supporting documentation must be received at the District Office
July 2, 2021	Scholarship award winner will be announced

Submitted applications will be reviewed and screened by the VA Dare Education Committee. All applications and information contained therein shall remain confidential.
